The aim of the Research Policy is to cultivate a dynamic research environment among both faculty and students at Indira Mahavidyalaya. It is intended to function as a comprehensive framework that guides and governs the conduct of research activities within the institution.

3. Scope:

This Research Policy is applicable across the entire college and is designed to be implemented in all departments of Indira Mahavidyalaya. It serves as a guiding framework and a set of guidelines for research activities throughout the institution.

4. Objectives:

- **4.1.** Establishing a conducive environment within the College to cultivate a research-oriented culture and offering necessary support through a structured research framework and guidelines.
- **4.2.** Guaranteeing a high level of efficient and effective support systems to assist faculty and students in their research endeavors.
- **4.3.** Ensuring publications in journals recommended by the UGC, peer-reviewed journals, and those indexed in PubMed/Scopus/Web of Science, or possessing an impact factor.
- **4.4.** Cultivating an atmosphere conducive to socially impactful research with the potential for commercialization.
- **4.5.** Creating Research Centers within the College aimed at achieving excellence.
- **4.6.** Facilitating interdisciplinary collaborations both within and outside the College campus and fostering partnerships at national and global levels.

5. Policy and Guidelines:

5.1 Undertaking Research

Faculty members at Indira Mahavidyalaya are anticipated to engage in research endeavors, resulting in high-quality publications, presentations at reputable national/international conferences, the creation of intellectual property with potential for commercialization, socially impactful outcomes, and other related research activities.

5.2 Obligations of Faculty

Research output will be considered as one of the criteria for faculty recruitment and promotion, in conjunction with other academic responsibilities.

5.3 Recruitment and Promotion

Indira Mahavidyalaya will seek to recruit faculty members with proven capabilities in research. Faculty promotions may be contingent on the extent of research undertaken. The evaluation of research output, particularly research publications, will be based on established criteria such as Impact Factor (IF), subject to periodic revisions as deemed appropriate.

5.4 Disciplinary Actions Against Academic Dishonesty

It is expected that all individuals engaged in research, including faculty, researchers, and postgraduate researchers, will uphold the highest ethical standards of conduct. This includes maintaining data integrity and adhering to ethical guidelines provided periodically for research activities. Introduction

Indira Mahavidyalaya, Kalamb is dedicated to advancing research and enhancing research practices. Research plays a crucial role in generating new knowledge, involving brainstorming, field and laboratory experiments, and observations. However, potential risks such as instrument handling hazards, chemical hazards, biosafety hazards, and fieldwork hazards must be minimized to ensure the safety, dignity, rights, and well-being of individuals participating in or associated with research activities. Therefore, it is imperative that research is conducted with the highest ethical standards, aligning with the values set by Indira Mahavidyalaya. In this policy, the term 'researcher' encompasses staff, students, and any other individuals engaged in research projects to which this policy applies.

This Code of Ethics in Research establishes overarching ethical standards to guide scholars toward the highest values in scholarly research. The principles delineate aspirational goals and set enforceable norms to steer researchers toward ethical behavior. Importantly, these principles align with the mission and values of our college. The Code of Ethics in Research is applicable to all faculty members at Indira Mahavidyalaya, Kalamb. As a result, the principles are expressed in a generic manner to apply to academics across diverse disciplines using various inquiry techniques, with the exact application varying based on the researcher's specific setting.

Preamble

The faculty and research staff at Indira Mahavidyalaya, Kalamb share a collective belief that our role as scholars involves a dedicated commitment to advancing knowledge and fostering the growth of students and fellow researchers. In addition to our endeavors to uphold the principles of scholarly integrity and academic freedom, we acknowledge our responsibility to align with the vision-mission of our institution and contribute to the interests it aims to serve and develop. Understanding our duty to the public, we pledge to maintain the utmost level of integrity and ethical standards, aiming to be deserving of the trust placed in us by the public.

Aim of Research Ethics Policy

To cultivate an environment and culture that embraces principles, regulatory requirements, and best practices, and to provide continuous support and training to both staff and students. This commitment is aimed at ensuring the maintenance of the highest ethical standards in their research endeavors.

Objectives of Research Ethics Policy:

- To ensure that all research activity undertaken by Indira Mahavidyalaya complies with agreed ethical standards.
- To promote and inspire researchers to undertake basic and applied research activities which has national and international importance.

A. Statement of Integrity and Honesty:

Anti-Plagiarism Policy

Introduction

Plagiarism, defined as the unauthorized use or reproduction of someone else's ideas, words, or work without proper acknowledgment, is strictly prohibited. All students, faculty, and staff are expected to adhere to ethical standards, citing sources appropriately and submitting only original content. Violations of this policy may result in severe consequences, including academic penalties and disciplinary actions. We emphasize the importance of academic honesty, fostering an environment where intellectual contributions are acknowledged and respected. Our commitment to anti-plagiarism measures reinforces the values of learning, integrity, and fair representation within our academic community.

Objectives

- To create awareness about responsible conduct of research, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and prevention of misconduct including plagiarism in academic writing among students, faculty, researcher, and staff of the college.
- To establish institutional mechanism through education and training to facilitate responsible conduct of research, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and deterrence from plagiarism.
- To develop systems to detect plagiarism and to set up mechanisms to prevent plagiarism and punish a student, faculty, researcher, or staff of our college committing the act of plagiarism.

Institutional Mechanism for Curbing Plagiarism

- The College would recognize Turnitin and Urkund software for Synopsis & Thesis Submission available with parent university.
- Also for publication, scholars, supervisors can go for other software such as Grammarly, Duplichecker, WhiteSmoke plagiarism checker, Quetext, Copyleaks or any other software desired by the individual.
- The mechanism shall be made accessible to all engaged in research work including student, faculty, researcher, and staff etc.

College Adopts Similarity Checks for Exclusion From

Plagiarism The similarity for plagiarism shall exclude the following:

- All quoted work reproduced with all necessary permission and/or attribution.
- All references, bibliography, table of content, preface, and acknowledgements.
- All generic terms, laws, standard symbols, and standards equations.

Levels of Plagiarism

Levels of Plagiarism Plagiarism would be quantified into following levels in ascending order of severity for the purpose of its definition:

- i. Level 0: Similarities up to 10% Minor similarities, no penalty
- ii. Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40%
- iii. Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60%
- iv. Level 3: Similarities above 60%

Penalties

Penalties in the cases of plagiarism shall be imposed on students pursuing studies at the level of master's and Research programs and on researcher, faculty & staff of the College only after academic misconduct on the part of the individual has been established without doubt, when all avenues of appeal have been exhausted and individual in question has been provided enough opportunity to defend himself or herself in a fair or transparent manner.

- Level 0: Similarities up to 10% Minor Similarities, no penalty.
- Level 1: Similarities above 10% to 40% Such student shall be asked to submit a revised script within a stipulated time not exceeding 6 months.
- Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60% Such student shall be debarred from submitting a revised script for a period of one year.
- Level 3: Similarities above 60% -Such student registration for that programme shall be cancelled.
