- Upon approval by the Research Committee, faculty members may proceed with the application process to the respective funding agency.
- Faculty members are encouraged to seek guidance and support from the institution's research support services for proposal development, budgeting, and administrative procedures.
- The institution provides necessary support, such as infrastructure, facilities, and administrative assistance, to facilitate the successful implementation of research projects.

5. Ethical Considerations:

- All research projects must adhere to the highest ethical standards and comply with relevant regulations and guidelines, including those related to human subjects, animal welfare, biosafety, and intellectual property rights.
- Faculty members are responsible for obtaining necessary ethical approvals and ensuring the ethical conduct of research throughout the project duration.

6. Reporting and Accountability:

- Faculty members who receive research funding are required to submit periodic progress reports to the funding agency and the institution's Research Committee.
- The institution will monitor the progress of research projects and provide necessary support to overcome any challenges encountered during the implementation phase.
- Faculty members are accountable for the proper utilization of research funds in accordance with the approved budget and guidelines of the funding agency.

7. Review and Evaluation:

 The institution will conduct periodic reviews and evaluations of its research activities to assess their impact, identify areas for improvement, and ensure alignment with institutional goals and national priorities.
